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## DEVELOPING LIBRARY-BASED ENGLISH TEACHING LEARNING ACTIVITIES FOR THE FIFTH GRADE OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS AT SD AL MUJAHIDIN WONOSARI

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#### ABSTRACT

The objectives of this study are to find out the possible library-based activities and the characteristics in the English teaching and learning processes at class VA of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari in academic year of 2011/2012.

This study is Research and Development (R and D). The procedure was as follow: conducting the needs analysis, writing the course grid, developing the activities, conducting the implementation, evaluating the designed activities, and revising the activities. The subjects of this research were the students of class VA of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari. The questionnaires and interview guideline were used to collect the data. The questionnaires were divided into two parts. The first questionnaire was to obtain the data about students' needs to develop the activities and distributed in the early stage of the study. The second questionnaire was used to revise the activities and was distributed during the implementation of the activities. The quantitative data from the questionnaire were analyzed by using central tendency measure. Meanwhile, the qualitative data were analyzed through interpretational analysis technique.

The developed activities were formulated into a course grid, a teacher's guide, worksheets, and media. There are possible learning activities in the product (1) Story book-based activities (2) Video-based activities (3) Scrabble-based activities (4) Picture dictionary-based activities (5) Encyclopaedia-based activities. There are five aspects in the library-based activities that match with the students' characteristics: appearance, content activity, activity type, topic, and media. The results of the developed activities are called effective and feasible to be applied if the obtained score mean for appearance was more than 22.5; the content activity was more than 9; the activity type was more than 18; the topic was more than 13.5; the media was more than 13.5. In conclusion, the developed activities are appropriate and feasible to be used in the teaching-learning process at class VA of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari in academic year of 2011/2012.

#### **CHAPTER I**

#### **INTRODUCTION**

#### A. Background of the Study

Generally, English teaching and learning processes in Indonesia are done in the class room. The variations of the learning setting are still rarely done by the schools. However, there are some schools that have done the variations occasionally. Those variations are done to give another interesting way in learning English that are possible to apply in English teaching and learning for children.

The variation of the teaching and learning setting is not only aimed to avoid the monotonous but also to support the activities of the students while they are learning. The choice of the location should be based on the activities that will be done in the teaching and learning processes. It is related with resources that the students need to do their activities. Activities here are mentioned as the things done in the process of learning such as games, project, story telling, filling worksheet, and many more.

In the learning processes, it has been realized that each student in each school and level needs a variation. The variation is not only in the learning activities but also in the place where students can find many resources beside their course book and the location of the teaching and learning processes so that they are not bored. Related to that, some schools have been using the variation in their learning processes but some others are still using daily

classroom and course book only for their teaching and learning processes. The variations of the teaching and learning location that are mostly used by some schools are school yard, corridor, school garden, and other available places in the school area.

Recently, English teaching and learning processes have been done by doing the variation of the location in such activities. Unfortunately, this thing is only done by some schools and some English courses. In fact, English teaching and learning process is important to be done in a fun way and in the right place especially for children. It has a relationship with the characteristics of children where they can not learn in a monotonous way that will make them bored and can not acquire the language easily.

Library is one of the locations that can be a good resource for the students in their English teaching and learning processes. It is a must to be existed in a school and have many resources for the students in acquiring many things. Related to the case, there are good schools that have good libraries where the collections and the arrangement are good. However, the libraries are not optimally used, especially in teaching and learning processes whereas the teachers can find many resources there as an effort to develop their teaching and learning processes that are based on the curriculum.

In relation to a good school that has a good method in teaching and learning process, there are lots of good Elementary schools in Gunungkidul that have criterion to be a good school. One of those good schools is SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari. SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari is a favourite school in

Gunungkidul. Here, the learning method is planned in a good one. But, in doing the activities in the teaching and learning processes, the school still uses daily classroom only and the library that has a good library designed with many resources is not used optimally yet.

Since SD Al Mujahidin is a school that has a good library and learning method, it will be good if the students are given a variation in the location and resources of their learning processes to make them reach their better achievement. Here, providing activities that are designed to be done in variations will give enthusiasm to the students that are related to the library as a good resource to support the teaching and learning processes. The research is intended to create some activities that are based on library in the English teaching and learning processes that will be done with variations of the location and resources.

#### **B.** Identification of the Problem

In English learning process, students especially children have to be placed in a pleasant condition. It is related to children characteristics that they are very easy to be bored when they are learning in school. In their learning processes, children need to be placed in fun activities so that they can have their motivation to learn. Here, children can exercise well when they are motivated as the result of their innate that they are happy to try new things and to experiment with ideas (Pinter, 2009:5)

Nowadays, there are lots of qualified schools that have been using good media and activities in their English teaching and learning process. Not only good media and activities, they also have complete school facilities. Then, the problem here is that the schools are still using an old method whereas the activities and other learning supports are good. Here, the whole activities are done in the class room and without any variation in the learning resources that will make the students feel bored and have some difficulties in acquiring the language.

SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari is one of favorite schools in Gunung Kidul that has been using good media and activities in their teaching and learning process. Besides, the school is also has good school facilities. However, the problem is that the school still uses class room only in their English teaching and learning processes. The school does not use other places to find some more resources in doing their activities

Related to that, library is a good resource to fulfill the needs of learning variation. In the library students can find many books and some other information. The arrangement of the table and some pictures that exist in the library will give another atmosphere in learning English. Here, library can give some benefits as the learning resource. However, the teachers of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari have not use the library yet in their English teaching and learning processes. They do not know how to create activities and to use the resources in the library.

Those are some things that become considerations in developing activities based on library based activities. As the researcher's knowledge, there has not been any research that conducted with the aim to provide more suitable activities in English teaching and learning process that is done by using library as the main resource. Therefore, this field research hopefully can be a contribution for the development of Elementary school in Indonesia in general, and for SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari in particular.

#### C. Limitation of the Problem

Concerning the limitation that the researcher has, the researcher is going to conduct a research focusing on the development of teaching and learning activities design using library based activities. It will deal with the whole components of the teaching and learning plans. The components are sequenced with the students' level of competence so that it will be as appropriate as possible for the students.

The designed activities that follow the materials is made to be applied by using many resources that exist in the library. It deals with kinds of activity that are appropriate to be done with many resources in the library. The setting of the place is the consideration of the need in the variation of learning place. In addition, it is related to the need of appropriate places that are depended with the activities. This research therefore will mainly discuss the development of effective activities design in learning English based on library based activities.

#### D. Formulation of the Problem

Based on the limitation of the problem, the researcher formulates the problems as follows:

- 1. What are the possible library-based activities in English language learning at grade five of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari?
- 2. What are the characteristics of library-based activities in English language learning at grade five of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari?

#### E. Research Objectives

Corresponding to the formulation of the problem, the objectives of this research are as follows:

- to identify the possible library-based activities in English language learning at grade five
- 2. to identify the characteristics of library-based activities in English language learning at grade five of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari.

#### F. Research Significance

This study is expected to give some contributions as follows:

- 1. For SD Mujahidin Wonosari
  - a. For the students of grade five at SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari, this study offers an opportunity for the students to do some other fun activities that will facilitate them to acquire language well.

b. For the English teacher of grade five at SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari, this study can be used as an alternative technique to do their English teaching and learning activities.

### 2. For English Department

The researcher hopes that the result of this research study can be a reference related to the activities development.

#### **CHAPTER II**

#### LITERATURE REVIEW AND CONCEPTUAL FRAMEWORK

In this chapter, the researcher presents the theories of library-based activities and conceptual framework of this research. The theories will cover the factors that influence the activities design in this study, those are children characteristics, teaching English to children, characteristics of activity, types of activity, activity development, characteristic of the library, children library, and library in the teaching and learning process. Those theories will be discussed bellow.

#### **A.** Literature Review

#### 1. English Teaching and Learning for Children

#### a. Children Characteristics

Children characteristic is the features that form children's personalities. In relation to their personalities, children by the age of ten can understand abstract and symbols that begin with words (Scott and Ytreberg, 2004:4). Further, Brewster et al. (2002:27) say that in the learning processes, children learn things slowly. In contrary, they forget things quickly as the result of their innate that they are bored easily. Meanwhile, it is known that children can exercise well when they are motivated as the result of their innate that they are happy to try new things and to experiment with ideas (Pinter, 2009:5).

Children's innate are quite different with adults. A child's spontaneous and attentions of language forms and awareness are different from adults (Brown, 2001:87). In relation to the awareness of the language, most of eight to ten years old children will have some varieties of language awareness and readiness in their foreign language classrooms (Scott and Ytreberg, 2004:4). Here, it is known that teachers have to give different treatment when they are teaching children.

In their effort to acquire language, children need adults to mediate them with the world in making language accessible to them. Cameron (2001:6) states that "with helps from adults, children can do and understand many more things than they can on their own". The things that children can do and understand should be designed into physical activities. It is connected with the children's characteristic where "children have a lot of physical energy and often need to be physically active" (Brewster et al, 2002:27). From those explanations, it can be concluded that children need helps to acquire things and they need to have physical activities to exert their physical energy.

Vygotsky in Cameron (2001:6) states that "the child is an active learner in a world full of other people. Those people play important roles in helping children to learn, bringing objects and ideas to their attention, talking while playing, reading stories, and asking questions". Moreover, Brewster et al. (2002:28) discover that "children may start their school with good concentration and memorization skills, having been introduced to action songs, counting rhymes, bedtime stories, computer games, and so on". It can

be concluded that people have their important role in helping children to do many things by giving some interesting activities first when they are going to start their school.

#### b. Teaching English to Children

Teaching English to children is different from teaching it to adults. It should be suited with the characteristics of children. It is mentioned that "teachers need to create a balance in their classrooms between providing support and providing challenge to their students in the teaching and learning process" (Brewster et al., 2002:40). Besides, it is known that "teachers need to examine classroom activities from the child's point of view to asses if pupils are understand of what they do and able to make sense of new language" (Cameron, 2001:19). Here, it can be concluded that in teaching children, the teachers need to have the ability to create activities that are suitable with their students. Besides, the teachers have to give motivation for their students so that they can acquire the competence well.

In creating the lessons, teachers have to match it with the pupils' needs. In their learning processes, children need to have partners to discuss their activities so that their lesson can be easier to be mastered. Related to that, Brewster et al. (2002:43) states that "pupils will have lots of opportunities to talk or read and write together if they are set into pair or group work". In addition, Scott and Ytreberg (2004:15) state that "Pair work is a useful and

efficient way in language teaching to children. It makes the learners and the lessons are simple to be organized and easy to be explained".

In teaching the skills, teachers should include the barest minimum of grammar. In this case, the teachers can introduce some sort of simple grammar when the learners ask for an explanation (Scott and Ytreberg, 2004:6-7). Moreover, in the process of transferring the materials especially for more difficult concepts or patterns, the teachers have to do it with repetition that becomes an important thing in teaching children (Brown, 2001:88).

#### 2. Activities

"Activity is intended as practice material, to supplement activities in the pupils' book, and to be used in conjunction with a teacher's book" (Cameron, 2001:22). Moreover, it is mentioned that activities "have language practice as their aim and include such things as becoming more familiar with new vocabulary, grammar and language functions or practicing skills such as listening for detail using charts" (Brewster et al., 2002:49). From the definitions above, it can be concluded that activity is used to be a practice material after the students have their lesson that covers skills in language learning.

#### a. Characteristics of Activities

The activities that are designed contain skills. Related to that, Brewster et al. (2002:49) state that "activity, like traditional exercises, focus

on the guided teaching and learning of specific items of language, skills, or knowledge". In addition, Cameron (2001:21) says that "activities are seen as the environment or ecosystem in which the growth of skills in the foreign language takes place".

In the whole, "activities are used as a means of prepare pupils for more independent work on tasks" (Brewster et al, 2002:49). The works or tasks will be counted as a success for those that cover the learning needs of pupils. It is quite different with the activities that only fulfill the demands of the text book unit or to the teachers' interest (Cameron, 2001:1). Related to the learning needs, "it is useful from time to time to give pupils a selection of different activities to be chosen from. This allows pupils to choose activities based to their own interests and needs, decide for themselves what to do, and plan their own works" (Brewster et al., 2002:56). From the theories above, it is clear that activities are used to facilitate the students to be more independent with their work that cover their learning needs where the students can select their own activities based on their interest and needs.

There are some characteristics of activity in English teaching and learning processes. The characteristics are based on the student's needs, language demand, and student's characteristics that cover many things in each factor. Those factors are connected each other that influence the success of the activities done in the English teaching and learning processes. Related to that, the characteristics of activity are drawn by Brewster et al. as the following:

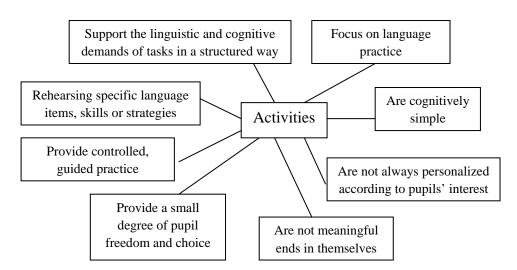


Figure 1. Characteristics of Activities. Proposed by Brewster and Ellis (2003:51).

#### b. Task Activity Type

There are activity types in the English teaching and learning processes for children. Those activities are designed to be as interesting as possible to make the students happy in joining the activities. Those activities are:

#### 1) Listening task

Listening is the first skill that the students learn in their English teaching and learning processes. Lines (2005:30-33) states that listening activities are better to do with Total Physical Response (TPR) activities. Here, the students give response from the teacher's command and begin to speak by repeating their teacher's command. TPR activities can be done by using song, finger-plays, and storytelling. Moreover, Scott and Ytreberg (2004:21-28) suggest some activities that are used to improve student's

listening skill such as 'Listen and do' activities, listening for information, 'Listen and repeat' activities, and listening to stories

#### 2) Speaking task

Lines (2005:52-56) states that Audio Lingual Method (ALM) is an appropriate method to do speaking activities. It is done by doing drill with choral response and dialogues where puppets can be useful to be the model of the different dialogues. In addition, Communicative Language Teaching (CLT) is also possible to do speaking activities. Here, the students have their authentic activity, for example have a role-playing of a flight attendant and an airline passenger. Moreover, Scott and Ytreberg (2004:34-39) proposes some activities that cover speaking task, those are (1) 'presenting new language orally' that can be presented by using mascot, through the pupils, drawings, silhouettes, and puppets; (2) 'controlled practice' that has a close relation with presentation that is important for the children to try out new language as soon as they have heard it; (3) 'guided practice' where the teachers can use pictures, objects, or miming to help the children understand the content; and (4) 'dialogues and role play work'

#### 3) Reading task

According to Lines (2005:81) it is important to give a predictable story and pattern story that contains repetitive phrases and predictable language in learning reading skill. Besides, pattern book is important because it contains illustrations that help the students to understand some words, sentences, or pattern that are repeated in the text. In line with Lines, Scott

and Ytreberg (2004:54-63) states that the activities used to improve student's reading skill are reading a story from a book, reading a class story, reading texts based on the child's language, reading familiar nursery rhymes or songs. Moreover, there are some reading materials that can be used for the reading activities such as reading cards, home-made books, picture dictionaries, and books with tape.

#### 4) Writing task

There are some activities that are possible for the students to learn writing skill. Lines (2005:112-114) proposes group writing where children can work collaboratively on a writing project, talking and writing box, writing conference that very useful to help children in doing revising, inventive spelling that is based on students' developing cognitive and literacy skills, and word walls. Besides, Scott and Ytreberg (2004:70-73) suggest some activities that cover writing task, those are straight copying, matching, organizing and copying, delayed copying, copying book, and dictation.

#### c. Activity Development

In the process of acquiring language, there are some activities that are packed into tasks. The activities that are using language in creating meaningful tasks promote language. In this case, task is an activity that is carried out using language (Richards and Rodgers, 2001:223-224). Moreover, activities are used for stimulation of input-output practice and focused on conversation (Richards and Rodgers, 2001:229).

The application of the tasks is done after pupils have studied the materials. Brewster and Ellis (2002:50) states that "task ... emerge after pupils have studied a particular set of language and help to provide a context to ensure that learning has taken place". Moreover, Cameron (2001:26) states that "learners can do the tasks, and weather they learn anything by doing it, depends not just on the demands or on the support, but on the dynamic relationship between demands and support". In addition, Cameron (2001:24) also states that "language demands are those related to using the foreign language and the use of mother tongue in connection with learning the foreign language".

From the explanation of some theories about activity development above, it can be concluded that activities are available in tasks. Activities have a close relation to language learning that are done after the students have their material study. In developing the activities, the balance between the demands and the support has to be done. The demands and support are suited with the learners to make it appropriate for them.

#### 3. Library

#### a. Characteristics of Library

The word *library* derives from the word *liber* or *libri* (Latin) that means *book*. Library is always connected with books. Moreover, the definition of library can not be separated from the development of the library's collection (Basuki, 2009:1.2-1.7). In addition, Basuki (2009:1.19) said that

"library is a knowledge which is arranged orderly and connected with the purpose, object, function of the library, and the function, method, arrangement, technique, and theory that are used in the gift of library service".

Referring to those definitions of the library, Bennet (2003:4) states that

...libraries as services places where information is held, organized, and managed on behalf of those who use it.

.....

... library as a space where learning is the primary activity and where the focus is on facilitating the social exchange where information is transformed into the knowledge of some person or group of persons.

Based on the definitions above, it can be concluded that library is always connected with books and the development of library's collection. The collections of a library consist of information. The information are transformed into knowledge that related to the library service. The information from the library can be transformed to some person or group of persons.

By its characteristic as a learning resource, library collections should include a larger variety of materials that show a more world-wide view of the human experience. Further, Basuki (2009:1.5) states that the materials include in the library covers printed work or graphic work such as books, magazines, news papers, and reports; non printed work or recorded work such as audio records, VCD, and micro opaque; electronic work such as floppy disk, and magnetic tape; library materials that are associated with computer; and *e-books*. Moreover, International Federation of Library Association (2003:9) mention that "children's library should include a variety of

developmentally appropriate materials in all formats including printed materials (books, periodically comics, brochures), media (CDs, DVDs, cassettes), toys, learning games, computers, software, and connectivity".

From the statement above, it is known that library's collections that provide information need to have varieties of material. Libraries not only need to have books but also audio visual facility. Besides, children's libraries need to make available some toys and learning games as their collections. It is useful to create students' interest with library.

As a general rule, library should have enough seating for one class that is completed with one additional seating area. This thing will be useful if there is a session where teacher wants to work with a class (Baule, 2007:34). In this case, libraries are used in the teaching and learning process. In addition, Fitzsimmons (2007:5) proposes nine feature of an effective school library, they are:

- 1. accessible to the total school community, on site or remotely
- 2. cost effective because one book is used by many
- 3. provides flexible scheduling and timely access to the collection by all students
- 4. offers a broad range of materials-references, fiction, and nonfiction
- 5. addresses a broad range of reading levels
- 6. minimizes loss through cost-effective tracking systems
- 7. supports learning to read and reading to learn with informational and imaginative text and literature
- 8. adds new resources throughout the school year to keep collections dynamic
- 9. creates a sense of ownership that is shared by the entire school community.

From the criteria that are mentioned above, it can be concluded that libraries need to have enough space for the students to express needs in the

library. The needs of the students in the library include the books, accessible collection, and imaginative literature to support their learning. Besides, libraries have to provide things that improve the sense of ownership for the user.

#### b. Children Library

A good library must have a good design. It is important to make it accessible for the user. Here, Dene (2010:12) proposes that

A classroom library should be kid-friendly. Books should always be neat, organized and easy for the students to find. If students are unable to find what they are looking for, they will not be motivated to enter your library. Put books into temporary piles. Some possible piles may be fantasy, mystery, folktales, science fiction and poetry.

From the statement above, it is known that the arrangement of the library collection is an important thing in influencing students' interest to enter the library. The book collections need to be organized based on the category so that the students' will not have any difficulties to find what they want to find.

Related to the pleasure of the children while entering the library, it should be designed as a place in which children have chemistry with their surroundings. Further, Black and Rankin (2009:8-9) suggest that libraries must have a large number of pictures displayed in the wall and shelves with bright, lively, and homely decoration. In addition, Baule (2007:62) states that the color of the wall is also important as a requirement. The color of bright crisp is suitable for Elementary schools libraries. The colors of red, bright yellow and

oranges are better to be avoided. It is known that colors with a more calming effect are often better in school library media center.

Further, Black and Rankin (2009:8-9) suggest that the furniture of the school libraries should be in a suitable size and appropriate to the needs. It will be better if the table can be folded away so that the room is available to be teaching space or performance space. It is useful to be a place where children could not just come to read books but to express themselves in a constructive play.

There are some considerations of an ideal library design proposed by Onal (2009:7-14) that are derived from the result of an effective combination of many related functions. These include:

- 1. many children consider libraries to be welcoming institutions. The most effective location for children's services is at the heart of the school and public libraries
- 2. the library has an intimate and welcoming atmosphere both inside and outside
- 3. comfortable, quiet, easily supervised, and adequately heated, cooled, and lighted single and group study areas for long term use
- 4. computers and books distributed throughout the library, at the entrance, in the book stacks, near reading places, and at user service points
- 5. a tea juice milk service area for casual meetings and book discussions is open during library hours
- 6. a centralized reference desk staffed to monitor and service all topical areas
- 7. a quiet place in the library to read a book or study reference materials
- 8. clear space is vital to the proper functioning of a facility. But, in here, it is required to avoid designing anything that encourages young children to run, jump, or climb
- 9. the planning of furniture includes form, shape and color, in relation to use, as well as durability and flexibility. The ease of cleaning furniture, traffic flow, and ways of storing tables and chairs are also important

- 10. a place for children where they can listen to stories, look at puppet shows, play games, and conduct research on the Internet
- 11. comfortable area to do homework / group projects
- 12. libraries for children cover multipurpose rooms, community meeting rooms, conference rooms, and supporting services
- 13. study space in which noise is tolerated and welcomed; and computer workstations with Internet access
- 14. space to display art; and separate magazine, CD, video, and DVD collections.

From the consideration above, it can be concluded that the location of the library is better to be placed in the heart of school so that it can be a welcoming institution for the children. The atmosphere of the library both inside and outside has to create an intimate feeling. It is related with the design of library where it is made to be comfortable and quiet where books are distributed in many corners of the room. Library is designed not only to facilitate the children to read books but also to be a place where children can listen to stories, look at puppet shows and play games. However, it is prohibited to design library that encourage children to run, jump, or climb. Moreover, library has to cover all kinds of material and resources that are needed by the children such as magazine, CD, VCD, and DVD. Besides, it has to be multipurpose room so that it can be an interesting point for the children.

#### c. Library in the Teaching and Learning Process

School library is different with public library. School library is direct into academic life that supporting and advancing teaching and learning processes (Bennet, 2003:21-22). In the library, the skill that becomes the

most important task is reading (Malman, 2001:2). In addition, Fitzsimmons (2007:7) mentioned that library will enrich the teaching and learning process in some ways, those are:

- 1. they teach skills and strategies where students need to learn and achieve
- 2. they are partners in educating students, developing curricula, and integrating resources into teaching and learning
- 3. they teach the skills students need to become effective users of ideas and information
- 4. they seek, select, evaluate, and utilize electronic resources and tools and instruct teachers and students in how to use them.

The theories above give the knowledge that library is useful to teach skills and become a partner for the students that cover all aspects in advancing their learning.

In relation to library as a teaching and learning support, Fitzsimmons (2007:4) states that "library is an important instructional partner of consultants in supporting and expanding existing curriculum. It works with teachers to change what is possible in the classroom and support exciting learning opportunities with books, computer resources, and more". Connected with the case, Onal (2009:4) states that "library can be stated as a curriculum based information services, homework assistance, information literacy units, and reading development programs". From the theories it ca be concluded that library can be a good resource for the teaching learning processes that has many advantages to support the activities.

School library can be a second classroom where students have their collaboration with the teachers to have another meaningful lesson with

information that brings them both in the classroom and the real world (Fitzsimmons, 2007:2). In the learning process, students are preferred to learn in group study or types of seating. Here, library providing group study space much more than individually study (Bennet, 2003:17).

#### **B.** Conceptual Framework

The purposes of this research are to identify the possible library-based activities and the characteristics of library based activities in English language learning at grade five of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari. The reasons to conduct the study are that (1) the school library of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari is not used optimally whereas there are lots of resources exist in the library; and (2) the teachers of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari do not know how to create activities and to use the resources in the library. To solve those problems, it is necessary to develop library based activities for students at grade V of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari.

Based on the theories, activities by using library are appropriate to be done in the English language learning for children. It is referred to the children's characteristics where they like to try new things and to experiment with ideas and the advantages of library that supports many resources for children's learning processes. In doing the activities, children need the adults to mediate them with the real world that is caused by their innate where they can be bored easily when they are learning. However, they can concentrate well if they are interested with the activity.

Related to the activities that the children have in learning English, it should be based on children's point of view. They like to learn by using videos, pictures, tape, music, and some other media. Those activities are used to support their books that include real communication to make it essential for language learning that consist of some skills. Besides, it is used to prepare children for independent work on task and allow the students to express their ideas and needs in their English language learning.

Activities are designed into tasks that are required by the learners to arrive at an outcome from given information through some processes. It is done after the children have studied a particular set of language. The activities should be designed with varied location and resources. It is useful to avoid children's bored feeling.

Related to the variation of the location in doing the activities, library is a place where information and some learning resources exist to facilitate children in their English language learning. The information that exist in the library will support the material of the learning whereas the setting will avoid the boredom of the learners in acquiring the skills so that designing activities that are conducted in the library will be useful for English teaching and learning processes.

### **CHAPTER III**

#### RESEARCH METHOD

### A. Type of the Study

This research is classified as an Educational Research and Development (R&D) category. R&D is used to develop and evaluate a new product that is applied in an educational program. Sukmadinata (2006:165) mentioned that R&D shows a cycle that begins with needs and problem where they are solved by using certain product. Its primary goal is discovering new knowledge and incorporating it into a product that can be used in the schools.

The product of this research is developed to meet specific needs that are based on the detail specification tested and the revision until a specific level of effectiveness is achieved. The result product in this research is in a form of Elementary learning activities that is based on the library.

### **B.** Setting of the Research

This research was conducted in SD Mujahidin Wonosari. It is a religion-based school located in Jl Mayang, Gadungsari, Wonosari, Gunungkidul. There were 456 students, 43 full time teachers, 7 part time teachers, and one headmaster. This research was conducted at class VA that consists of twenty eight students.

#### C. Research Instrument

Instruments are used to gather the data and to conduct the analysis. In this research, the researcher used questionnaires to get the data. There are two kinds of questionnaires used in this study. The first questionnaire was distributed to get information about the students' needs. The second questionnaire was distributed to get the information about the development and the implementation of the library based activities.

### 1. First Questionnaire (Needs Analysis)

The aim of this questionnaire is to get data about the students' characteristics and needs for developing activities. The organization of the questionnaire is as follows:

#### **D.** Research Procedure

### 1. Conducting the needs analysis

Conducting the needs analysis was the first step that the researcher did in this research. It is aimed to find out the students' needs and interests. The information is about students' English learning, the setting of the learning process, the way students learn (group work/individual work), the task activity type, the topic, the skills, the media, and teacher participation in the teaching and learning process. The data that have gathered were used as the basis of the next step of the research.

### 2. Writing the course grid

After conducting the needs analysis, then the researcher wrote the course grid. This step is used as the guideline in developing the library-based activities. The writing of the course grid is based on the result of the needs analysis and the review of the school-based curriculum. Here, the researcher tried to describe the standard of competence and the basic competence to be used as the basis in developing the activities.

### 3. Developing the activities

The course grid was used as the guideline to develop the library-based activities. Related to that, the researcher consulted with her supervisor to get feedback. In the development of the activities, the researcher developed the library-based activities that consist of nine units and several activities. Each unit consists of teacher's guideline and students' worksheets.

### 4. Conducting the implementation

The researcher validated the library-based activities to experts before it was implemented to the students. The library-based activities were implemented at grade VA of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari that consists of twenty eight students. After the implementation, the researcher asked some feedback from the students and the English Teacher.

#### 5. Evaluating the designed activities

In evaluating the developed activities, the second questionnaire was conducted. It was done by giving the second questionnaires to all students in class after trying out the activities. Besides, the researcher interviewed the teacher in order to get the feedback and opinion about the developed library-based activities. Here, the feedbacks were in scores and suggestions

#### 6. Revising the activities

After the evaluation, the researcher revised the library-based activities. The activities were revised based on the feedback suggested by the students and the English teacher. The final product of this step is the final draft of the activities.

#### E. Data Collection

The data in this research was collected in two separated times. The first time of the collection data was used to find out the data of the learners' needs and characteristics. The type of the first questionnaire was multiple

choices where the students were asked to choose one or more options from several provided options. Besides, they were allowed to give other answers in some questions. The second time of the collection data was done during the implementation of the library-based activities design that was used to revise the developed activities. Here, the researcher used the Likert scale to collect the data. In this case, the respondents were asked to respond whether they Strongly Agree (SA), Agree (A), Undecided (U), Disagree (D), and Strongly Disagree (SD) to the statements in the second questionnaire.

### F. Data Analysis

In collecting the data, the researcher used questionnaires. There are two types of questionnaire used in this research. The first questionnaire is used in the analysis of students' needs and interests. It is analyzed by using interpretational analysis technique. The results of this questionnaire were used as a guideline in developing library-based activities that contains the description of students' characteristics and needs in learning English.

In the second questionnaire, the data is in the form of scores and suggestion. The researcher used a Likert Scale in collecting the data. According to Arifin (2009: 159-161), there is a score in each indication of the response to the statement. For Strongly Agree (SA), the score is 5. For Agree (A), the score is 4. For Undecided (U), the sore is 3. For Disagree (D), the score is 2. For Strongly Disagree (SD), the score is 1.

For the second questionnaire, the data obtained in this research were in form of score. The data were used to analyze each aspect of library-based activities design. The steps of data analysis are explained as follows:

a. Changing the categories into numbers by using Likert Scale as mentioned in Table 3:

c. Defining the Ideal Mean and the Ideal Standard Deviation

Ideal Mean (Mi) and Ideal Standard Deviation (SDi) are used to know the quality of the library based activities designed. According to Arifin (1991:101-103), the computation of Mi and SDi can be obtained by the following formulas:

#### **CHAPTER IV**

#### RESEARCH FINDINGS AND DISCUSSION

### A. Research findings

### 1. Needs Analysis

In this research, needs analysis was the first step to design the library based activities. It was conducted by using the first questionnaire about the students' interest in learning English. The information from the first questionnaire was used to get the data of the students and the descriptions of their learning needs. Besides, the researcher conducted class observation and interview to the English teacher. The results of the needs analysis were explained as follows:

#### a. Children's Characteristic

There are 28 students of class VA. The range of students' age was from ten to twelve years old. The data of the respondents were presented in Table 5 below.

The students in class VA were very active and confident. They loved to study and learn something new. During the English class, the students were studying and doing the class activities with a good passion. They had

their enthusiasm to pay attention to the teacher's explanation or instruction related to the material and activities. They wanted to be the first to answer teacher's questions about the material, to finish the task or to do something in front of the class related to the English learning activities. Furthermore, outside their class activities, the students had enthusiasm to learn English. They often read English or bilingual story books in the library. Besides, they often had a conversation with their friends in English. They were able to produce simple sentences and use the vocabulary that they have learned in their English class.

#### b. Children's Needs

Since the focus of this research was to develop library-based activities in English teaching and learning process, needs analysis was aimed to gather the information of the students' needs on the kinds of activities that were based on library. The analysis of the students' needs was based on the result of the data from the questionnaire administered to the students. In this step, the questionnaire was considered as the first questionnaire. There were some aspects of the first questionnaire, those aspects were students' opinion about English subject, setting of the learning process, students' learning model, task activity type, topic of the activities, media, kinds of skills, and teacher role. The data of the needs analysis were summarized in Table 6 below.

In the first aspect of the first questionnaire, there were three questions that consisted of two choices in each question to find out the students' opinion in learning English. It was concluded that majority of the students liked English subject where two students who did not like English thought that English subject was difficult to learn while the other 26 students thought that it was easy to learn. The last question in the first aspect shows that majority of the students thought that they had fun English teaching and learning processes these far.

Regarding to the second aspect of the first questionnaire, it was known that majority of the students did not feel bored when their English teaching and learning processes were done in the classroom, however they were agree if it was done outside the classroom. Furthermore, responding to question about the possible places for the English teaching and learning processes outside the classroom, majority of the students liked to do the activities outside the classroom. Based on the result, it was concluded that the possible places to be used in the English teaching and learning activities outside the classroom were library, school garden, and school yard.

The third aspect of the first questionnaire tried to find out whether the students liked to do the activities in group or individually. It was concluded that majority of the students liked to do the activities in group and choose their own friends for their group work. Moreover, the students wanted to have four members for their groups and used the group permanently.

Dealing with the fourth aspect of the first questionnaire, there were some results that became the most important things to be the consideration in

developing library-based activities. The result in the fourth aspect of the questionnaire showed that majority of the students chose listening to a story, playing game, doing dialog, having discussion, and playing crossword puzzle to be the activity type in their English teaching and learning processes.

The next aspect of the first questionnaire tried to find out the topic that the students liked to be used in the activities. The type of this aspect was similar to the fourth aspect of questionnaire. The result of the fifth aspect of questionnaire showed that majority of the students chose 'animals', 'fruits', 'transportation', and 'sports' to be the topics of the task activities in their English teaching and learning processes.

In the sixth aspect of the first questionnaire, the researcher tried to find out the things to be used in the process of the activities. Those things were media that would make the activities became more interesting and easier to be done. The result of this aspect of questionnaire showed that majority of the students chose pictures, video, and cards to be used as the media for their English learning activities.

The seventh aspect of the first questionnaire tried to find out the skills that the students liked to do. The type of the question in this aspect was similar to the sixth aspect. There were four choices where the students had to choose one or more choices. The result of this aspect showed that most of the students liked to do all kinds of skill.

The last aspect of the first questionnaire tried to find out the teacher role that the students need in the process of doing the activities. There were two questions in this aspect. The result of the first question showed that all

students agreed to have their teacher's help in finishing their English learning activities. The second question asked the students about kinds of help that they need in their English learning activities. The result showed that majority of the students need the teacher to explain the procedure of the activities and the new vocabularies in the activities.

#### 2. Course Grid

As mentioned in the previous chapter, writing the course grid was the next step after doing the analysis. It was written as a guide to develop library-based activities. The course grid was written by considering the result of the needs analysis. The analysis of the students' needs was used as the guideline in developing the activities. Besides, there were standards of competence and basic competences used in developing the appropriate library-based activities. However, due to the appropriateness of the library, materials, and the students' needs, the researcher developed some activities that were designed into nine units. Each of the unit would be conducted in 35 minutes.

### 3. Development

The course grid was used as a guide in developing the activities. There were nine units developed in the product as explained bellow.

### 1) Unit I

In the first unit, the students learned how to ask and give services.

The activity type in this unit was conversing with the librarian. Here, the students used some library facilities as the object to be asked in the

conversation. Furthermore, there were two types of activity in this unit, those types were completing the worksheet and practicing the conversation.

The first activity in the first unit was completing the worksheet. The worksheet helped the students in preparing their conversation with the librarian. Here, the students were completing the student's part of the conversation in the worksheet while the librarian part will be completed after they had the conversation by noticing the librarian responses. Moreover, in asking the service, the students were not allowed to ask for the same things with their friends. In this case, the students used some possible library collections and facilities to be asked. The use of the library collections and facilities would give a better recognition to things around the library for the students and enrich their vocabularies.

The next activity in the first unit was practicing to have a conversation with the librarian. There were two sessions in this activity, those were delegating the leader of the group to have the conversation with the librarian and making the leader of each group to act as a librarian for the group member. Regarding to the first session of the activity, the leader of the group would be the first student who had the conversation with the librarian for each group. While the leader had the conversation with the librarian, the leader and the member of the group noticed the librarian responses in giving services. Furthermore, in the second session of the activity, the leader of each group should act as the librarian for

their group member. Here, the group members were practicing the conversation in asking and giving services each other.

### 2) Unit 2

In the second unit, the students learned how to give information. The activity type of this unit was reporting a video. Here, the students were asked to give information about the content of the video. There were two types of activity in this unit. The first activity was watching the movie and the second activity was practicing of how to give information. Therefore, the library facilities that were used in the activities were VCD and video player.

The first activity in the second unit was watching a short movie. In this part, the students were asked to complete the first task of the second unit worksheet. Before watching the movie and completing the first task, the students were asked to read and comprehend the task. Furthermore, there were five discontinuous sentences to be completed in the first task to help the students gathering the information of the movie. Here, the students were allowed to watch the movie three times.

The second activity in the second unit was reporting or giving information about the movie to the classmates. In this part, the students were asked to complete the second task of the second unit worksheet. The second task was similar to the first task while it asked the students to complete the discontinuous sentences that were based on the first task information. The difference between the tasks was in the form of the

sentences. In the second task, the sentences were gathered in a paragraph that consists of the expressions in giving information. Furthermore, after completing the second task, the students were asked to tell the information in front of their friends by using the second task of the worksheets.

#### 3) Unit 3

In the third unit, the students learned how to ask and give information. The activity type in this unit was conversing with a friend. The content of the conversation was about the information gathered from the encyclopedia. Therefore, in doing the activities in this unit, the students used encyclopedia collections that were available in the library. The encyclopedia gave opportunity to the students to learn new things appropriate to their characteristic. Furthermore, there were two types of activity in this unit, namely completing the worksheet and practicing the conversation of asking and giving services.

The first activity in this unit was completing the worksheet. Before completing the worksheet, the students were asked to find the encyclopedia in the library. They were asked to observe and notice some important information from the encyclopedia. After that, the students were asked to comprehend and finish the worksheet by completing the discontinuous sentences.

The second activity in the third unit was practicing the conversation by using the worksheet that was completed by the students

in the first activity. There were some expressions of asking and giving information in the worksheet that were combined with the information of the encyclopedia. In this case, the students were worked in pairs and practicing the conversation of asking giving information in turns with the other couples.

#### 4) Unit 4

In the fourth unit, the students learned how to pronounce words, phrases, and simple sentences fluently. The activity type in this unit was reporting the English story book. There were two types of activity in this unit, those were completing the worksheet and reading aloud their works. Here, the students were pushed to be able to pronounce each word correctly. Furthermore, in the process of the activities, the students were allowed to use the English story books available in the library. The students could enjoy the books and enriched their vocabulary while the books were designed with pictures and full color appearance.

The first activity of the fourth unit was completing the worksheet. The students were asked to complete the worksheet by using the English story books. They were asked to observe and notice some important information from the books. Moreover, there were three tasks in the first activity that the students should do. The first task was finding some information of the English story books. There were some pictures and statements in the task. Those pictures and statements were provided to help the students found the information. The second task was finding

some words. Here, the students were asked to find some words that they never found before. The last task was finding some sentences. Here, the students were asked to read aloud some sentences that they like.

The second activity in the fourth unit was reading aloud the students' finding from the worksheet. The students were asked to read aloud their finding fluently in front of the class. Before doing the activity, the students were taught to pronounce the new words that they have found in the English story books.

## 5) Unit 5

In the fifth unit, the students learned how to identify information in simple pictures and texts. The activity type in the fifth task was finding information. In the process of doing the activities, the teacher used VCD and video player as the facilities of the library. There were simple pictures and texts that were presented in form of flash video to make the students interested with the activity. Furthermore, there were two types of activity in this unit those were watching the video and filling the worksheet.

In the first activity, the students were asked to watch a video with pictures and texts. Here, the students were asked to identify the information from those pictures and texts. Before watching the video, the students were given worksheets for the next activity. Furthermore, in this first activity, the students were allowed to watch the video for three times

In the second activity, the students were asked to gather information from the video and fill the worksheet. It reflected the students' ability in understanding something from the pictures and texts. There were two tasks in the second activity, namely matching and answering question. In matching activity, there were pictures and words to be matched by using the information given in the video. Then, in answering question activity, the students were given six questions with pictures to help the students answered the questions.

#### 6) Unit 6

In the sixth unit, the students learned how to identify information in sentences. The activity type in this unit was finding information. The students were asked to find information from sentences. In this case, the students used bilingual story book collections to do the activity. Bilingual story books helped the students to understand the content of the story easily while there were two languages in the books, those were English and Indonesian. Furthermore, there were two types of activity in this unit, those were reading a bilingual story book and filling the worksheet.

In the first activity, the students were asked to find bilingual story books in the library. They were asked to read the books and noticing some information from the books. Before doing the first activity in this sixth unit, the students were taught about some important points to be found while reading a book so that they would be able to find important information of a story.

In the second activity, the students were asked to fill the worksheets. There were two tasks in the worksheet that related to some important information about the story of the book. The first task was completing discontinuous sentences that consisted of six sentences. Then, the second task was consisted of two questions that gave the opportunity to the students in expressing their opinions about the story of the books.

### 7) Unit 7

In the seventh unit, the students learned how to write English sentences accurately. The activity type in this unit was words finding. Here, the students were finding some words from the dictionaries that they could learn some new words. It was appropriate with the students' characteristic that they were happy to find something new. Therefore, the library facility that the students used in the seventh activity was picture dictionary. Moreover, there were three tasks in this unit that were ordered from the easy task into the more difficult task.

The first task in the seventh unit was finding some words from the dictionary in noun form. There were five boxes in the task that consisted of three words for each box that the students should find from the dictionary. The words were categorized by using the same first letter for each word. Here, the students were free to choose the first group letter of the words to be gathered.

The second task of the seventh unit was identifying pictures. In this unit, the students should be able to recognize the name of some noun in the pictures. There were four kinds of thing to be mentioned in the boxes beside the pictures. Those four kinds of thing were the students' favorite topic based on the questionnaire. Furthermore, in this second task, the students were asked to write the name of the words accurately.

The third task in this unit was writing simple sentences. There were ten sentences that students should write in the worksheets. In writing sentences, the students were asked to choose some words that they have found in the previous tasks and write some sentences with the words based on the example. This was used to make the repetitions for the students that were important in their learning process.

### 8) Unit 8

In the eighth unit, the students learned how to write English sentences accurately. The activity type in this unit was word finding. In this unit, the aim of the activity was the same with unit seven. The difference was in the library facility that was used in the activity. In this unit, the students used scrabble to do the activity. It was useful to make variation for the students in writing sentences so that they were happy to write something. Furthermore, there were two genre tasks that the students should do in this unit. The tasks were in form of picture and sentence cards.

In the first task, the students were given cards that contained sentences and pictures. Here, the students have to write sentences based

on the cards. They were imitating the sentences from the cards into the scrabble. Besides, the students were asked to comprehend the sentences that they have written.

The second task of the eighth unit served cards with pictures and questions. The second card was more difficult than the first. There were two things that the students need to be aware, those were the question and the picture. The students were asked to answer the questions in the card that based on the picture included in the card. After finding the answer, the students were asked to write it by using the scrabble accurately.

### 9) Unit 9

In the ninth unit, the students learned how to copy and write simple English sentences. The activity type of this unit was listing. The library facility that was used in the activities of this unit was English story books or Bilingual story books. Moreover, there were two types of activity, those were reading a story book and making lists.

The first activity of the last unit was reading a story book. The students have their freedom to choose the book that they want to be used. In this case, there were some benefits of using those facilities, such as to teach the students to be confident with their choice and to know what they really want so that they would enjoy with the activity. In this first activity, the students were introduced with subtitles that were available in a story book.

After reading the book, the students were asked to find the first sentence of each subtitle in the books. Here, the students had to know the subtitle that the teacher has taught before. At last, the students were asked to copy and write the first sentence of each subtitle accurately.

### 4. Implementation

In the implementation, the researcher collected the information from the students. The researcher implemented the product to the students at grade VA of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari. It was done after the researcher validated the product to the experts to get the feedbacks. Those feedbacks were used to revise the product before the implementation.

The implementation was conducted on June 19, 2012 until June 21, 2012. It was done after the students had their final examination that the researcher had much free time to do the implementation. Here, the students were given the second questionnaire to revise the developed activities. Besides, the researcher also gave the second questionnaire to the English teacher of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari.

The first day of the implementation was conducted on June 19, 2012. There were 28 students who attended the class. There were three units implemented in a day. The activities of the first day implementation can be seen in the following table.

Table 7 shows that in the preparation activity, there is an introduction of the expressions in asking and giving services to the students. Here, the teacher uses puppet or other media to teach the material. In core activity, there were only some students who asked to practice the expressions of asking for services to the librarian. Those students were the delegations of each group. While asking for services to the librarian, the delegations were asked to study the way to give services from the librarian response in their short conversation. Moreover, after asking for services to the librarian, the delegations were asked to act as the librarian for their groups. The members of each group were asked to practice the expression of asking for services to the delegation and study the way to give services from the delegation response.

Table 8 shows that there are two materials to be taught in the preparation activity, those are giving information and expressing like and dislike. In introducing the way to give information, the teacher used sentence cards or a poster that contained the steps in giving information. Then, in introducing the expression of like and dislike, the teacher used sentence cards. Furthermore, in core activity, the students were asked to watch the movie and complete the worksheets. There were two tasks in the worksheet. The first task was completing sentences based on the information of the movie. The second task was completing a paragraph that contained the steps in giving information by using the information of the first task. In the last activity, the students were asked to report the information of the movie based on the second task in front of their friends.

puppet and sentence cards. Furthermore, after the introduction, the students were asked to learn with encyclopedia. They were asked to find some information of the encyclopedia and write the information into the worksheet. Moreover, the students were asked to practice the expressions in asking and giving information based on the worksheet. In this case, the students had the conversation with their partners in front of their classmates.

The second day of the implementation was conducted on June 20, 2012. There were 28 students who attended the class. There were three units implemented in that day, those were unit 4, unit 5, and unit 6. The activities of the second day implementation can be seen in the following table.

activity the students were asked to pronounce words, phrases, and simple sentences correctly based on the worksheets.

Moreover, the students were asked to tell the information to their classmates and imitate the attitude of the object in the pictures.

The third day, the last day of the implementation was conducted on June 21, 2012 and attended by 28 students. The units to be implemented were unit 7, unit 8, and unit 9. The activities of the third day implementation can be seen in the following table.

### 5. Evaluation

Evaluation was used to evaluate and validate the product in order to make the product ready to be used by the students. The validation was done by the experts. Furthermore, there was an evaluation done after the implementation. Here, the researcher did the evaluation by gathering the data from the students and the English teacher by giving the second questionnaire. The result of the questionnaire gave feedback to the researcher that was used as the evaluation of the product.

# 2) Try Out

There were 28 students of class VA of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari asked to participate in the try out. Here, the researcher distributed the second questionnaire to the students and the English teacher. The second questionnaire was used to get the data to evaluate and revise the product in order to find the kinds and the characteristics of the library based activities for the students at grade V of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari.

### a) Data from the Students

The total score and the mean of the students' agreement toward each aspect in the second questionnaire were presented in Table 17 below.

Based on Table 19, it can be concluded that the **Appearance** aspect was categorized into Very Good, because the mean was more than 22.5. Then, the **Content Activity** aspect was categorized into Good, because the mean was more than 7 and less than 9. Meanwhile, the **Activity Type** aspect was categorized into Very Good, because the mean was more than 18. The **Topic** aspect was categorized into Very Good, because the mean was more than 13.5. The last was the **Media** aspect that was categorized into Very Good, because the mean was more than 13.5.

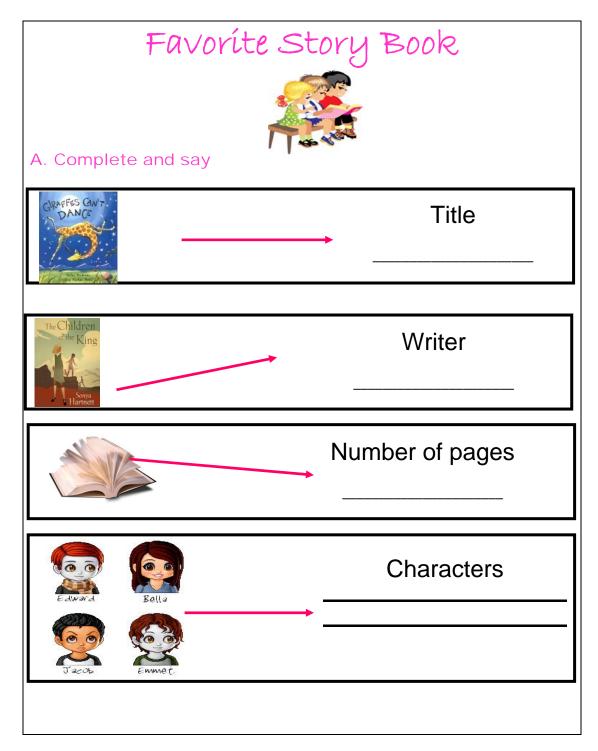

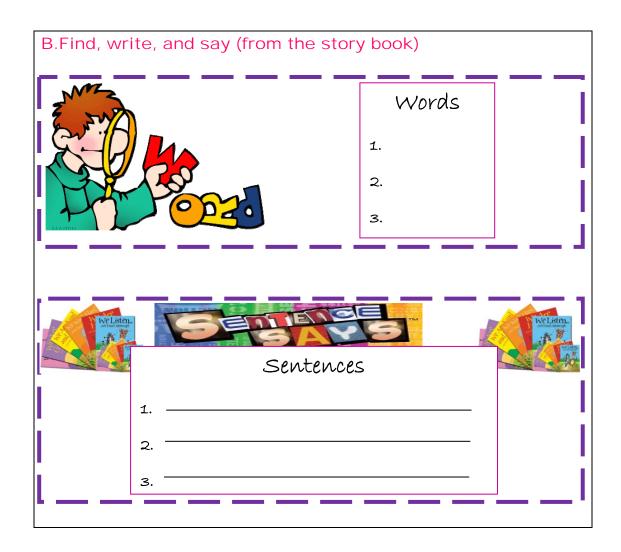

#### **B.** Discussion

In this section, the researcher presents the discussion about the possible library-based activities and the characteristics of library based activities in English language learning at grade five of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari in academic year of 2011/2012. The discussion is presented below.

#### 1. The possible library based activities

There were some various types of activity of the library-based activities design. Each activity was designed based on students' needs, interest and characteristics. Moreover, library was a place where the students could find good resources and facilities to study and learn something new. There were some facilities in the library of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari that could be used for English learning activities. Those facilities were useful to be the consideration in developing the library-based activities. From the students' needs, interest, characteristics, and the facilities of the library, there were some possible activities developed.

#### 1. Story Book-Based Activity

There were three activities designed by using story books, those were reporting English story book, finding information and listing. Those three activities were useful to increase the students' ability in reading comprehension and enrich their vocabularies. As long as the students were loving books, it was possible for the researcher to develop lot of activities by using books. Moreover, there were two kinds of book to be used in this kind of activity, those are English story book and bilingual story book. The use of the books in the activities was based on students' knowledge in English. In this case, the bilingual story books were used for more complicated activities such as identifying information.

In addition, there was one activity that was designed by using story book as a compliment. In this case, the book was a tool to be used in the transaction between the librarian and the students. Here, the activity was conversing to study the way to ask and give services in borrowing a book. This activity was design related to the basic rule of the library that the students need to know when they want to borrow something from the library.

#### 2. Video-Based Activity

There were two activities designed by using video-based activity. Those two activities were reporting information and identifying information. In the activities, the students had to identify some information from the content of the video. The video-based activity was useful to increase the students' vocabulary, pronunciation, and their listening skill. Here, the students learn something new by watching and

observing. Since the students at grade VA of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari had a good passion to watch and observe something, the researcher developed some activities by using video.

#### 3. Scrabble-Based Activity

There were two activities designed by using scrabble, those were copying and answering question. Here, scrabble-based activity was expected to enrich students' vocabulary and give an interesting challenge for the students to do the activities.

#### 4. Picture Dictionary-Based Activity

There were three activities designed by using picture dictionary, those were finding words, mentioning words, and writing sentences. Picture dictionary was a good resource for the students in learning vocabulary. In this case, the activity that used picture dictionary would make the students interested and could enrich their knowledge in English. Besides, picture dictionary could make the students curious to find something new.

#### 5. Encyclopedia-Based Activity

There were two activities designed by using encyclopedia, those were conversing and completing sentences. Encyclopedia served many kinds of knowledge. Students could learn many things from the encyclopedia and enrich their vocabulary. Based on the students' characteristics at grade VA of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari, encyclopedia would give a passion for the students to do the activities.

#### 2. The characteristics of library-based activities

There are some characteristics of library-based activities design that were developed based on the students' needs analysis. Those characteristics are mentioned below.

#### 1. Done with a good library

Library-based activities are done with a good library. The design of the library should be appropriate with the children characteristics by using good color and decoration. The collections and the facilities of the library should be complete so that the students can have varied activities.

#### 2. Done in some other places

The library-based activity is not necessarily done in the library. The main point in the library-based activities is that students use the facilities, the collection, and resources of the library. Therefore, the activities must have various places to do the activities so that the students are not bored to join the activities. Here, library is a place to find some resources and good facilities to be used in learning English.

#### 3. Providing some group work activities

Discussion is one of the activities that the students need to do in the library-based activities. Related to that, the students are given group work activities. By using the group works, the students can learn to be cooperative and share their knowledge with each others. Besides, the students can improve their speaking and listening skills.

#### 4. Providing various kinds of activity

The various kinds of activity should be provided in a library-based activities. Those different kinds of activity are based on the students' need and interest that the researcher used in developing the library-based activities to make the students have their enthusiasm to do the activities.

#### 5. Providing various topics

The library-based activity should be designed in some different topics. The selection of the topics was based on the students' interest that became the consideration for the researcher in developing the library-based activities.

#### 6. Using various media

Media is something important to be used in learning something. In the library-based activities, there are some different media that are used to make the students interested with the activities. Here, the researcher used the facilities of the library to develop the activities optimally.

#### 7. Requiring the teacher's role

In doing the activities, the students need the teacher as a facilitator. Besides, the teacher is expected to explain the advantages of using the library facilities so that the students know the importance of the library.

#### **CHAPTER V**

#### CONCLUSIONS, IMPLICATIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

#### A. Conclusions

The objectives of this research are to find out the possible library-based activities and the characteristics of the library-based activities in the English teaching and learning processes at class VA of SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari in academic year of 2011/2012. The product of the library-based activities is formulated into course grid, teachers guide, worksheets, and media. Based on the research findings of the research study, the product of the library-based activities design are explained bellow.

1. The Possible Library-Based Activities

This study found that the possible library-based activities are as follow:

- a. Story Book-Based Activities
  - 1.) Reporting English story book
  - 2.) Finding information
  - 3.) Listing
  - 4.) Conversing with librarian
- b. Video-Based Activities
  - 1.) Reporting
  - 2.) Identifying information
- c. Scrabble-Based Activities
  - 1.) Copying
  - 2.) Answering question

- d. Picture Dictionary-Based Activities
  - 1.) Finding words
  - 2.) Mentioning words
  - 3.) Writing sentences
- e. Encyclopedia-Based Activities
  - 1.) Conversing with friends
  - 2.) Completing sentences

#### 2. The Characteristics of Library-Based Activities

This study found that the characteristics of the library based activities are as follow:

- a. Done with a good library
- b. Done in some other places
- c. Providing some group work activities
- d. Providing variou kinds of activity
- e. Providing various topics
- f. Using various media
- g. Requiring the teacher's role

#### **B.** Implications

Based on the result of the study, there are two implications that can be drawn bellow:

 After undergoing the try out, the possible library-based activities are regarded to be appropriate and feasible to be implemented in the English teaching and learning processes for the fifth grade of Elementary school students in SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari. The implication to this fact is that the library-based activities can also be used to the fifth grade students in other schools that have good libraries and similar characteristics with the students at SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari.

2. The research findings show that there are some results of the library-based activities characteristics for the fifth grade of Elementary school students in SD Al Mujahidin Wonosari. Those results are needed to develop the library-based activities. The implication to this fact is that the teachers should use those characteristics when they want to develop good library-based activities.

#### C. Suggestions

Related to the conclusion and implication above, there are some suggestions that presented below.

1. Suggestion to the Headmaster of Elementary Schools

The headmasters are expected to provide good libraries that have the collection of the English and bilingual story books. Besides, the headmasters are expected to provide the collection of the English short movie that can be played in the library.

#### 2. Suggestion to the Librarians

The librarian is expected to organize the collections of the library as well as possible. For the story book collections, the librarian is expected to put the English story book collections in a different shelf with the bilingual story book collections.

#### 3. Suggestion to the Decision Maker at DISDIKPORA Gunungkidul

The decision makers are expected to pay attention to the importance of the library for the elementary school students. There must be something different with the library for the high school students related to the decoration, the facilities, and the collection.

#### 4. Suggestion to the Elementary School English Teachers

The Elementary English teachers are expected to develop their own librarybased activities based on the students' characteristics, students' needs and the facilities of the libraries.

#### 5. Suggestion to the Other Researchers

The other researchers are expected to use the activities developed as an input for them to develop more interesting and effective library-based activities.

#### 6. Suggestion to the Students of English Education

The students of English education study program are expected to be more creative in developing the activities of the English teaching and learning processes in Elementary school. Moreover, they are expected to look for the opportunities around the school environment to be used as resources in developing some interesting activities.
